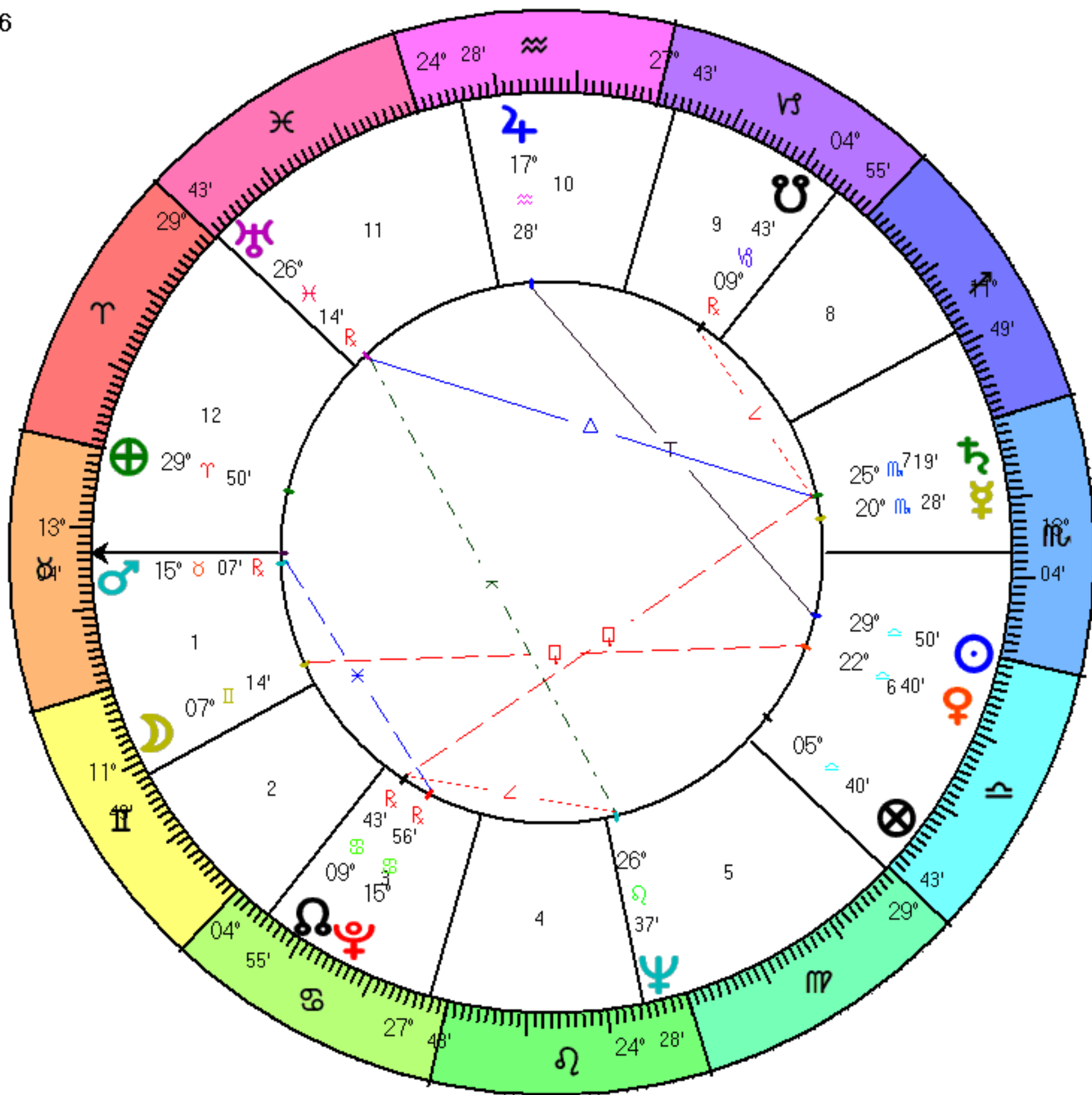

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TTTTA p40-41..... 26 October 1926:

Hi folks,

In the past, there's been much speculation about Gann's approach to astrology in TTTTA and we have seen previous examples of Gann's astroanalysis posted here, from a helio perspective.

However, it is important to keep an open mind about such matters and at least **CONSIDER** using both helio and geocentric options, in our analysis.

Here's one example of a geocentric approach, using a date that has been discussed extensively, on many Gann-related forums 26 October 1926.

Our attention is brought to the Sun, by the "sunshiny" afternoon mentioned in the P40 text.

In this instance, we read that Robert and Marie spent Saturday and Sunday together, implying that something changes, after that.

..... and so it was, if we accept that Robert is the Sun and Marie is Venus, then they spent Saturday and Sunday together in Libra (a loose conjunction), but on Monday they are parted, with the ingress of the Sun into Scorpio.

Yet again, we see another tredecile aspect appear between Jupiter and our Sun, this time.

None of the above analysis could be seen, using a heliocentric chart, but again we should also look at the helio chart, where we can see yet **ANOTHER** tredecile. See chart below.

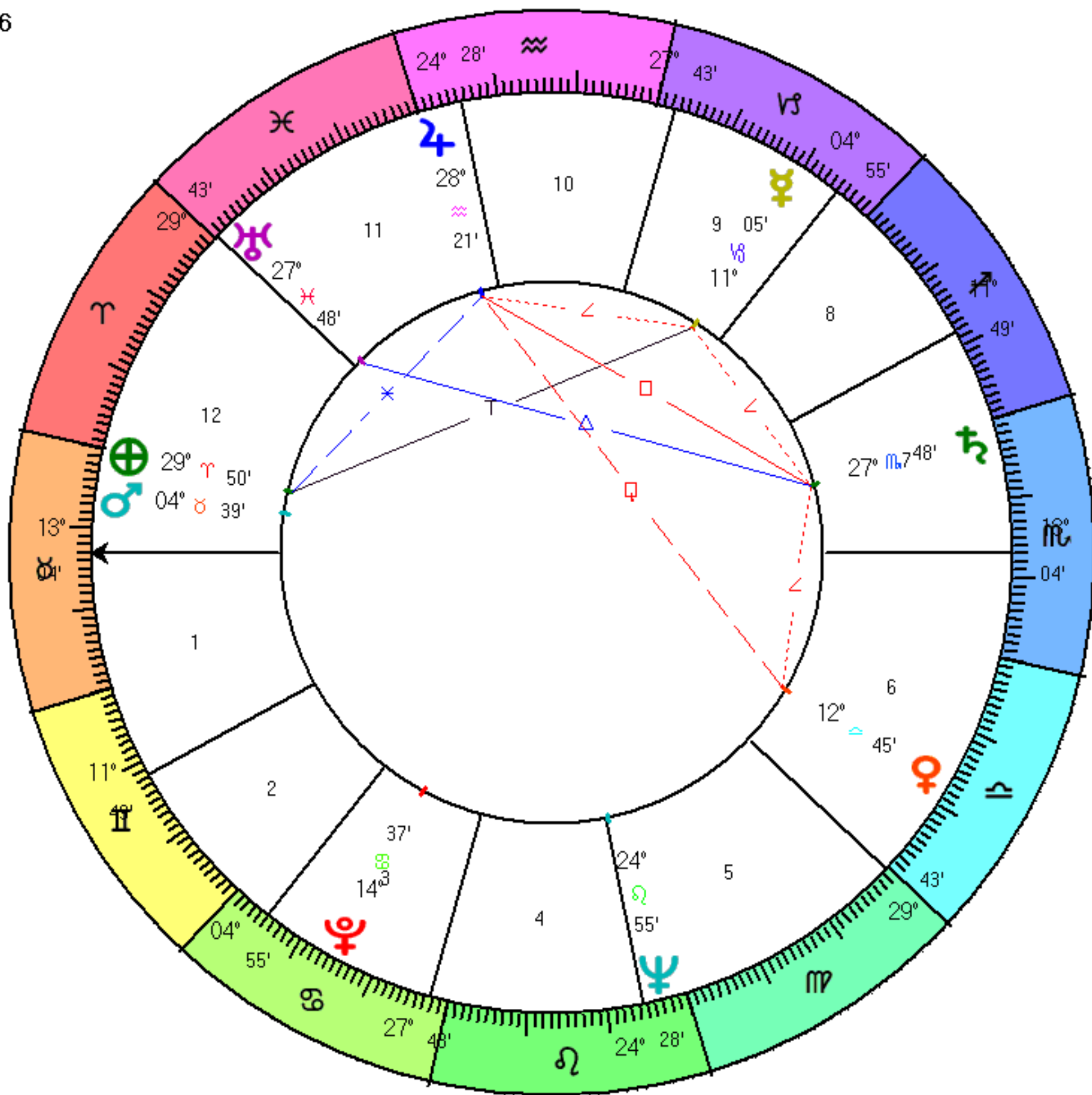
This time, it relates to Mercury and the Earth, as it makes it is ingress into Taurus and a sextile to Jupiter, as well as applying a loose conjunction to Mars.

You will also notice the sesquisquare, between Venus and Jupiter and across that 135 degrees aspect, there's three semi-square aspects of 45 degrees each.

Those aspects are shown, between Mercury/Jupiter, Mercury/Saturn and Venus/Saturn, as well as the included square, between Jupiter/Saturn.

For TTTTA purposes, an aspect of least importance is also shown ... an exact trine between Saturn and Uranus.

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So, for a more detailed analysis of the dates presented in TTTTA, maybe it is wise to consider both helio and geocentric views yes ???

On page 41, Gann expands on the astrocharts above, by explaining Robert's focus on specific parts of the Bible and how he came to understand natural law and cycles of war, famine and pestilence, according to the Bible.
