

Chapter 1

In the beginning.....

In the beginning, a supernatural being started it all, who is above and controls all things that didn't come on its own account or existence. This Great Celestial Being created everything natural on Earth and in the universe called the heavens. Children, have you ever asked your parents where did babies come from? Your parents should respond to you that babies come from their mothers' womb; which is an organ that holds and nourishes the baby until it's ready to come out. Everyone that comes to Earth has to do this as your parents and their parents had to also. This reproduction started way back to the first man called Adam and the first woman called Eve when they made babies that grew and made more babies. The Supernatural Being who is called God created these two people thousands of years ago near the Garden of Eden.

But there was a time before theirs, when these first two people were created, is when God mysteriously came into existence. Nothing created Him and nothing was before Him, God is the beginning and the end as the Alpha and Omega. God was made from matter that could self-appear that no man was able to name or identify. This unnamed matter would be too powerful to touch, view or to come near to. This is why in the bible it states that man has not seen God and lived. This self-made matter was the major part of God's being, but this was not the only matter that was in God. There are many unnamed materials in the universe that man is still unable to identify today! Even the mystery force of gravity is still being studied! In addition, if you study and look at the table of the elements in chemistry, there are new elements that are still being named, studied, and added. For instance, what is the surface of the universe consist and made of? Where does it end and begin? The bible doesn't speak any of these things and how God came into existence and the matter that He is made of. It does say that He is spirit. God wants to keep how He existed hidden. But in revelation, it states that everything will be revealed at the end of time.

A spirit is consist of a vapor and electricity along with many other chemicals that are found in our bodies, which consist of about over 98%

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of matter of the universe. God has a spirit that is made from the same matter and elements as our spirits are. Before He came into existence, it had to have been a dark “space” that consisted of nothing. Imagine for a moment that it was no stars, planets, galaxies, heavens, skies, sun or clouds. Then all of a sudden a self-propelling matter appeared. This matter is VERY powerful genetically-scientifically and is more than likely of no form, odorless, and possibly consist of an unusual powerful electro-magnetic gas that can destroy all physical and possibly great parts of spiritual matter if it comes to close to it. This could be the only matter or material that does not exist in terrestrial or even most celestial creatures. God is not consist of flesh and blood, He is only consist of celestial matter along with other powerful elements that are within Him. These powerful elements are not visible to the physical eyes without them being destroyed. After this self-propelled element existed, this was God himself along with other powerful elements that He’s made of. The next possible element that could have been a part of God’s development into existence is a water vapor that was produced from the heat of the gas and the surrounding cold, dark environment that turned the unnamed powerful gas into a powerful vapor mix. Just imagine how when you fix something hot or warm and put it in a cool or cold environment like a refrigerator or a cold room, you will see water or moisture appear soon afterwards, and water appears out of nowhere! Because of this mix, other elements could have created more elements; like electricity and light waves from the electricity which could have been the first sounds of roaring thunder from God coming forth into His existence. From the actions of the elements, air could have been formed in the mix of this Great Existence. Air alone is made of many elements like: nitrogen, oxygen, carbon dioxide, argon, neon, helium and some other gases; but the main ones are oxygen and nitrogen, with nitrogen being about 20%. Air is another odorless, tasteless and unseen gas that can only be felt and is another part of God.

Though, as many of the elements that are within God, they are in us also. The water and the gases that make up the air are in us as well as electrons that make up the electricity in God and us. We are made from almost all of the elements in the universe. This includes: iron, sulfur,

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nitrogen, electricity, water, calcium, copper, and most if not all of the other 113 plus elements that are in God as well. We and the animals are made from many complexes of elements that make one being, that one being is made of different elements that are more concentrated in more areas in the body than the other. One hair strain is made up of numerous of elements that make this one strain possible like many other parts of our body and spirit. After God came into existence, He more than likely created part of the Trinity with Jesus being first of His creations; and created the Holy Spirit. Once the Trinity was completed, they spoke to one another about the following creations. Everything God created was in spirit form before anything became physical.

The elements of spirits whether these spirits were humans, animals, or other creatures were created first. Once all the needed elements were created, each kind of spirit was of different dimensions and powers. Some of them had powers to control other spirits, there are spirits whose powers were just below God's power; and some also have magical powers. There are spirits that are also too powerful to become physical or carnal to enter a body and this is why some spirits will never become terrestrial beings and just remain celestial beings. There are spirits that can enter a physical body, but can be resurrected when it leaves the body; being resurrected means that when a spirit enters a body, it can leave a body and return to it after a certain period. The type of spirit we have can descend from heaven and into a body, which is not too powerful for this body to contain.

Some spirits may be too powerful to enter a body, but can transform into a weaker state in order for this to take place on Earth. Once our spirit enters a body, it only becomes temporary and the spirit will dwell in a terrestrial body; and once we die the spirit will dwell as a celestial being again. No flesh or bone can be where celestials dwell. Celestials have different elements with some being unknown compare to terrestrials. So, these unknown elements, besides the air, water, and electricity that are in our spirits are in God's spirit as well. However, His spirit has much more powerful elements than ours. There are so many elements that came from water or had been produced by water.

Examples of these elements and matter are: calcium, lime, mold, algae,

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fungus, minerals, and other elements on Earth and in the universe as well. Many of these elements come through soil and water also.

The elements that we are made of are what make up the body. But what about our feelings, the music that plays in our mind, dreams, thoughts and reasons along with daily operations of our bodies? Think about brain mass for a moment, it's flesh that is made up of nerves, chemicals, blood vessels, and other elements. All of these parts work fine until the spirit leaves the body. So, what is a spirit and what it consists to keep our bodies moving and functioning? When you try to figure out how God became who He is, take a look at us; particularly our spirits. It can be defined as: the thinking, motivating, feeling part of man, often distinguish from the body; mind and intelligence.

Now, what is in a spirit to make us do these things? Further definitions is that it also gives life, will, consciousness, thought, and connection to the spiritual world that is separate from physical matter. This complex, eternal and immortal part that's deep within us is a mystery to some people. How can something that is unseen with the naked eye that gives life, thought and will to our body that is unable to survive or thrive without it; is made of something that gives the body the ability to do what it needs to? It would take a deep meditating thought that could answer this question. Just think for a moment, that everything in your body is connected to something in order for the other to work. Your heart doesn't beat on its own account because it belongs to a system that it needs in order for it to beat, which is the central nervous system in the cerebellum area of the brain that eventually travels to the rest of the nervous system. The brain is the main line for your physical body, but again without the spirit it's nothing.

Like other things in life that has connections, your spirit has a connection as well. In the Book of Acts 17:28, it states that we live, move and have our being in God. After He came into existence, the intellectual part of Him came along with the spiritual parts of Him as well. The unknown physical matter that caused God to become in appearance has already been discussed, but what about the matter or chemicals that caused Him to have intellect, feelings, and will? There are certain parts of the brain that controls thinking, emotions, voluntary movements, etc.

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by different chemicals that are located in different areas. Some of these chemicals are hormones and the others are transmitters of the brain. Chemicals in general are usually made up of different combinations of other elements and other chemicals.

As God was coming into existence, the unnamed supernatural matter possibly could have been the main source of all elements, energies, and chemicals found in us after it mixed with other new components in a new environment. Eventually, those chemicals were passed onto us as part of our development. Our spirits are very much like God's spirit as far as similarities are concerned. However, His spirit is different in other ways also. It has much more power and ability and our spirits are just the branches and offspring of His. This spirit controls our life, feelings, thinking, dreams, and is very complex. This is something that was placed inside of us that never dies, enters its carnal level during conception and leaves the body after it's been injured or ill.

Here's another mystery question: how does a spirit stay in a body without it just randomly exiting? It seems that the only time that a spirit leaves a body is when the body is no longer able to sustain itself. How can the spirit remain in a body even after it's been traumatized or stressed? Is there a connection or certain chemicals that keeps the spirit and body attached before the body is too traumatized to contain a spirit? What causes the spirit to not be able to return to a traumatized body once it leaves that body? There could be an answer to these questions if you refer to something called a silver cord. This cord is invisible to the naked eye, which connects the body to its spirit.

The body immediately begins to decay once the spirit departs from it. Until this happens, the body is kept alive and warm while the spirit resides within. Unlike toys and other man-made items, the spirit constantly keeps us alive without replacement of devices to maintain it or recharging it. Once an item's battery (life of the item) is charged or replaced, that item becomes alive again. We have a battery that is eternal compared to a battery that needs to be replaced. Nothing on Earth lasts forever, but the spirit that's within a body is eternal. What is in a spirit that is not in a body that keeps it eternal that the body lacks? In the law of the universe, things that are unseen are eternal and things that are

seen are temporary.

Celestial beings have different genetic make ups than that of terrestrial beings. Some things that are unseen are in different atmospheres where earthly time and gravity doesn't exist. Also, there are different worlds in the universe where celestials reside. These different worlds inhibit different powers that operate. The part of heaven that God dwells in is more than likely where His existence appeared from. Not all spirits dwell in this part of heaven, because this area in heaven is so powerful certain spirits may not able to withstand the atmosphere of this highest world in the universe. The Earth's atmosphere is considered one of the lower worlds. Our spirits have been through different worlds. Humans are very unique creatures. Figuring out God's existence is beyond comprehension and understanding will always be a mystery. But we all still have to believe that we didn't create ourselves. If we had this much power, we wouldn't be on Earth; we'll be in a much higher place in the universe where we wouldn't need to be taught or guided to achieve higher knowledge, healings, or plans. There is no way to be able to create oneself without having supernatural powers to begin with.

Every creature has something greater than the other, like a spider that forms a web. Can man do that, though he can make the trains and buildings? Or a bird that makes its nest that doesn't fall apart; a beaver that creates a dam; or something immobile like a plant that has the DNA to bloom flowers or produce fruit, all of which, have spirits as well that never die within them. Everything God creates have the power to create also, even an element such as water; which creates waves, which create movement, which creates a new location, which creates a new environment that creates new life. A bird creates its nest so more generations can create more nests and offspring that will serve their purpose as messengers of God: "Curse not the king, no not in thy thought; and curse not the rich in thy bedchamber: FOR A BIRD of the air shall carry the voice, and that which hath wings shall tell the matter" (Ecclesiastes 10:20). God placed a spirit in each of His creations including the waters and gave a piece of His power to each being that can create or reproduce. After His existence, He knew what He wanted and what was in the future.

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Before everything became physical and that is seen in the present was previously in spirit form. God wanted to create a physical world below Him to allow certain spirits to be blessed and given an opportunity to show what a spirit can do in a physical realm of existence as well as being able to return to the original spiritual world. Here is a verse that tells us that man came from Heaven then to Earth: “And NO man hath ascended up to Heaven, but he that CAME DOWN FROM Heaven, even the Son of man which is in Heaven”(Luke 3:13). God created everything out of love and we were placed on Earth to be able to experience love even during the stressful trials of the lower world instead of just staying in Heaven Home to show love towards each other. Though after God created Heaven as our perfect home, He wanted us to dwell in a place where everything could be seen and temporary without perfection, which is the opposite of our Heaven Home in order to strengthen and teach us for a better preparation of an eternal higher level; which will be the next life to come after the return of Jesus Christ. We all were in Heaven, our original home after God’s existence. Further understandings of this necessary temporary visit to the physical world will be discussed.

In the beginning God created the heavens, Earth, plants, animals and man. He named the first man ‘Adam’(meaning man). God created this man in His own image and likeness, which He told to His fellow creators as being the Son of God, the Holy Spirit and possible other powerful creatures; as all three are represented as the Trinity. When God said, “lets make man in our image and likeness, was He referring to creating Adam? Was Adam really the first man created? According to 1 Corinthians 15: 45-47, the first man Adam was made a living soul; the last Adam was made a quickening spirit. The first man is of the Earth, earthy and the second man is of the Lord from heaven. If the first man was really Adam who was the last Adam? Evidently, the second Adam could have represented Jesus Christ. The Earth is still turning, people are being born everyday, the last man has not yet come.

After God Created the first man, He blessed them male and female to be fruitful and multiply, Genesis 1: 26-28. But when you read Genesis 2:4-7, “these are the generations of the heavens and of the Earth when they were created, in the day that the Lord God made the Earth and the

heavens.” Apparently, God created(already done) these generations when the heavens and the Earth were created the same day! Please re-read the previous sentence right before this one. Who was the first man, and the first female that was created with the man? And why would he have generations before him in the heavens and the Earth if this was suppose to be Adam? Continuing with Genesis 2: 4-7, “And every plant of the field before it was in the Earth and herb, for the Lord God had not caused it to rain upon the Earth and there was NOT a MAN to till the ground. But remember, God created man in His image and likeness; so where was the first man if it was none to till the ground? Referring back to Genesis 1:27 where it says, “so God created man in his own image male and female”, which was done by the 6th day and rested on the 7th day. It continued on to say, “but there went up a mist from the Earth and watered the whole face of the ground and the Lord God formed man of the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life and man became a living soul.” God created beasts after the 7th day from the ground also and named the man Adam, which whom named the beasts of the ground. At that time, God said that it was not good for man to be alone.

Now, back to how God created both Adams along with other types of bodies created. The first man was of the Earth, earthy; which could have been the slowest type of creation compared to how the second Adam was created. The second Adam was created as a quickening spirit, which possibly was a quicker way to create man by having his spirit entering a womb for carnal development. There are other types of bodies as well that have different make-ups of matter that consist of celestial and terrestrial bodies (2nd Corinthians 15: 40). Celestial is defined as being from Heaven, heavenly, or belonging to it. These bodies are either as angels, which are immortal or as planets dwelling throughout the universe that constantly renew themselves. Terrestrial is defined as an inhabitant of Earth, earthy; being created from Earth and its contents; things that are growing on land or in the ground. Another type of body is of the water, or being arboreal. This type of body mass lives, eat and perform other activities in water only.

In Genesis 1:20,and God said, let the waters bring forth abundantly

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the moving creature that hath life. So, did fish actually were brought forth in creation from water like man was brought forth from the dry parts of Earth, while sea life was from the wet parts of the Earth; instead of all creatures of the Earth being from the dry parts of it? It seems to be a mystery that man was created from the ground, but sea life could have not been created from the ground and instead was created from water. The celestials whom are made of eternal matter; terrestrials whom are made of temporary matter from contents of the dry parts of Earth; and the arboreal bodies which are made up of contents from water as being the wet parts of Earth are all different forms of creation from the elements.

When God put the first man of the Earth on it, He made him to name and have dominion over the other creatures. However, in Genesis 2:20 it states that Adam named the beasts of the dry parts of Earth or land; but didn't mentioned him naming species of the sea even though they are terrestrials of the wet parts of the Earth: "And God created great whales....which the waters brought forth abundantly...."(Gen.1:21); the whales were already named before Adam was created. What being named the fish? Was it God who seems to just bring forth all sea life from water comparing to forming man as well as beasts of the dust? Is there a special connection between man and beast since both are from the dust? Humans and animals do have the similar body parts in comparison, such as a vertebra and standing ability, along with breathing to exchange oxygen and CO₂. Do fish have a special place in God? The isthmus which is a symbol shaped like a fish that represents Jesus who fed thousands of people with fish could be a divine connection to sea life. Since Jesus was one of God's major co-creators, our Savior, could have named the fish of the sea and bonded a connection somehow.

God not only put man over beast on Earth, but also He granted man higher spiritual eminence over spirits of beasts. As mentioned earlier, there are different types of spirits that possessed different powers. These powers came along with levels of authority and dominion. Of all creatures of the Earth, man has the highest eminence, and dominion over all earthly creatures; whether they are animated or in-animated.

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The inanimate spirits have the lowest eminence while the animated spirits have higher dominion. The higher the level, the higher ability of connecting with God is achieved along with a level of conscience, will and instinct use of intellect. Spirits that dwell in inanimate creatures and objects like rocks, plants, and water has no ability to think at will or use instinct. They totally depend on God and parts of nature's activities to survive or exist. The higher spirits use will, intellect, and instinct to survive with an ability to connect to God. Man has the highest spiritual connection to God, but what about the lower spirits like the animals? Do they have a divine connection to God? Before these questions can be answered, we need to understand the difference of how animals and humans use instinct and freewill.

Instinct is the inborn-given intellect to different species that use it to their benefit. For instance, a bird need the instinct to make a nest in order to lay eggs; while a fox creates a den for its young; or a cheetah that hunts for its prey to satisfy hunger and to feed its young. Freewill on the other hand, is an ability to make a choice for survival; accomplishing an activity. Man uses freewill more often than animals, while animals use more instincts. Both man and beast have instinct and freewill. Many people believe animals only have instinct, which is not true. Animals as well as man have both instinct and freewill. Instinct is the autonomic natural character that is given by all animated creatures. Examples of instinct is when a creature is hungry it will find something to eat; when a part of the body needs to be scratched it uses nails instead of teeth; chewing food instead of swallowing it whole; to relief oneself; when a creature is in pain it will moan or cry; when something frightens it, it will run or panic; after a baby is born, it will develop a sucking instinct in order to be breastfed; a baby will cry when it first arrive, hungry or in pain; and if a creature is tired and sleepy it will automatically goes to sleep. Examples of freewill including the ones found in animals are: getting up to go to work; decision-making; solving a problem; go up or down a flight of stairs; drive a car or walk; caring for offspring; defend territory; fight or fleet; use of hygiene; mate selection and reproduction. Though man and animal have both instinct and freewill, both have spirits as well that go to different places after it leaves the body. The

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spirit of man ascends upward while animal spirits return to the ground and possibly go back to God. Animals' spirits came from Heaven as well as humans'. As it states in Genesis, God blessed man and animal to be fruitful and multiply. God is the head creator who gave all creatures powers to co-create and reproduce. The difference between co-creating and reproduction is that reproduction is when two mates create a copy of their species as offspring from their DNA. Co-creating is helping the creator to produce offspring by will. Creation by quickening is a great part of reproduction. Babies are created by reproduction as well as plants that disperses its seeds on the ground, by which, that same seed reproduced the same plant that dispersed the seed. The difference in creation compare to reproduction is that creation is when the creator used matter of different sources to create the creature or thing. Reproduction is copying from the source, by using the original matter to reproduce by developing the same offspring as the original or parent matter.

All creatures know when it's time for their reproduction. Also, they know other time of events that happen in their lives, as stated in Jeremiah 8:7: "Yea, the stork in the heavens knoweth her appointed times; and the turtle and the crane and the swallow observe the time of their coming; but my people know not the judgment of the Lord"; and this is how animals may somehow have a connection to God as well as man. Adam connected to them after naming them, because God didn't want Adam to be alone. After God created Adam, He didn't want him to be alone just with animals as stated in Genesis. This is when God put the man to sleep to create a companion that can relate to him better than animals could. During his sleep, God removed one of Adam's ribs and closed the flesh there of, to create woman; and Adam said, "therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave onto his wife and shall be as one flesh" (Gen. 2:24).

Apparently, God and Adam had known each other for awhile before woman was created and spoke with Adam about many things. Woman was not created separately like Adam as the first man was. The first woman was partially reproduced and formed out of the dust. The bible does not state exactly how the woman came about as far as her becoming

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a living soul by breathing the breath of life into her nostrils or stating that the Earth being a mist that covered the whole ground. Adam had to ask many mysterious questions to God after his awakening. One of those possible questions is that he asked, “what is a mother and a father?” Since he was the first man created, he had to ask God where did he come from and whom were the generations of the heavens and Earth? Why was woman created from a part of my bone? Although Adam was not made as a quickening spirit from the womb of another woman, Adam’s spirit had to come from Heaven as well; but it was entered into his body a different way than the people after Adam. The body of Adam was already fully developed after his creation and God knew Adam’s spirit and placed it in his body. Adam named his wife Eve, because it stood for the mother of all the living. God had created beasts in Genesis 1:24 and in 2:19, and the woman’s creation was mentioned in Genesis 2:22. Though this is a mystery, it shouldn’t be a total surprise; God creates and recreates very often even to this day.

After God created both Adam and Eve, why did He called both of them Adam? In Genesis 5:2 it says: God created male and female, blessed them and called their name Adam. The woman was already named Eve, who was the other Adam in this verse? Could this be other evidence that they were not the first and only people? The first generation mentioned was in Genesis 2:4, which any names weren’t mentioned; they were as hosts of the heavens and Earth. How were these generations of Adam created? Were they as quickening spirits or as living souls? In Genesis 2:2, is when God ended His initial creation and rested on the Sabbath Day and kept it holy. However, after Adam was awoken from the creation of Eve, he knew his wife and beget Cain; their first son and the first man to be conceived as a quickening spirit.

Another mystery after Cain grew and knew his wife and conceived, where did this woman come from , and from what generation? She was the second woman mentioned in genesis that was not named. She couldn’t have been part of Adam’s generation because she would have been too old for Cain to begin with. The moment Cain’s parents beget him is what started another generation.

Cain’s wife had to have had a generation of her own, even if she was

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much older than him; where and when did she come to appeared on Earth? This woman had to come from another generation or came from one of the generations of Heaven and Earth that God mentioned in Genesis 2:4. Her generation had to have been one that was close to Cain's for her to be in close age to him, which means that she had ancestors that could have been before Adam. Cain met his wife in the land of Nod, east of Eden that could have had more people created in the entire Eden area. Even if Cain's wife was created right after Eve, that would have even made her too old for Cain or he may just had a wife that was much, much older than him. Cain himself had to grow old enough to have a woman around his age, which he was created as a quickening spirit that caused him to come as a baby and grew into a man. How was his wife created, was she conceived or created from the ground? If Cain's wife was created from the ground, whom could have been the last one created from the ground? It seems that Adam could have been the only man created from the ground, since he seems to be the first man created and others were created as spirits before or after him.

After Adam and Eve's creation, it seems that the following humans were conceived and created as quickening spirits only. During Cain's generation, La'mech his great, great, great grandson took unto him 2 wives. Their names were Adah and Zillah (Genesis 4:20). Adah bare Jabal who was the father of such that dwelled in tents and had cattle; and his brother's name was Jubal who was the father of all such as to handle the harp and organ. Zillah also bared Tubal-Cain, an instructor of every artificer in brass and iron. These were the generations of Cain that were followed by even more people of his time and place.

Besides the creation of Adam and Eve and their offspring, there could be other strong evidence that Adam could have not been the first man and Eve as being the first woman. In the Book of Proverbs 8:22-36, states that we all were predestined in spirit form descending from Heaven then to Earth. First, in Proverbs 1:20: "Wisdom crieth without, she uttereth her voice in the streets"... Were the streets in Heaven or on Earth?

Resuming to Proverbs 8:22 which states: "How long, ye simple ones, will ye love simplicity? And the scorers delight in their scorning, and fools hate knowledge?..." To Whom, where and when Wisdom was speaking

these words? And it continued to say: “The Lord possessed me in the beginning of His way, before His works of old. I was set up from everlasting, from the beginning, or ever the Earth was. When there were no depths, I was brought forth, when there were no fountains abounding with water. Before the hills was I brought forth: while as yet He had not made the Earth, nor the fields, nor the highest part of the dust of the world. When He prepared the heavens, I was there. When He set a compass upon the face of the deep, when He established the clouds above...(she must have descended to Earth for Wisdom to say the “clouds above”)... when He strengthen the fountains of the deep, when He gave to the sea His decree, that the waters should not pass His commandments; when He appointed the foundations of the Earth. Then I(Wisdom) was by Him as one brought up with Him, and I was daily His delight, rejoicing always before Him, rejoicing in the habitable parts of the Earth, and my delights were with the sons of men” (mankind)these are the men that could have been before Adam... “now therefore hearken unto me, O ye children. For blessed are they that keep my ways. Hear instruction, and be wise, and refuse it not. Blessed are the men that heareth me, watching daily at my gates, waiting at the posts of my doors, for who so findeth me findeth life, and shall obtain favor of the Lord. But he that sinneth against me, wrongeth his own soul. All they that hate me love death.”

Referring back to Genesis 1:26 on God’s 5th day of creation, He created man in His image and likeness; male and female. If you read where Wisdom was rejoicing in the habitable part of Earth and her being with the sons of men, signifies that God created other beings before Earth was completed or came into existence. The part of the sentence that states the habitable part of Earth is saying that the Earth was not fully ready to be livable for creatures yet, which had to been before Adam; because Adam was created after the 7th day of creation, everything else on Earth had been created before Adam already. If you refer to the previous paragraph where it has the term “sons of men” usually means mankind particularly of Earth and not in Heaven. The term “Sons of God” usually means angels or other celestials that are very close to God. So, when was Wisdom on Earth? Was it before or after

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Adam? Who were these sons of men that Wisdom was with in the habitable parts of the Earth? It seems that Wisdom was a female being with great powers and very delightful to God who spent time on Earth as well as Heaven and having many human characteristics.

Somehow, we all were under the presumption that Adam and Eve were the first people besides Wisdom and other beings long before them. In Proverbs 9:1-3, it even states that Wisdom could have been with animals.

This is the parable: “Wisdom hath build her house, she hath mingled her wine, she hath also furnished her table, she hath hewn out her 7 pillars, killed her beasts, and sent forth her maidens: she crieth upon the highest places of the city”(What and where was this city?). It seems that Wisdom, this female spiritual human being was mingling with many sons of men along with living life of privileges by having maidens in Her presence. She was with other humans and beasts after God created the habitable parts of Earth that possibly was before Adam and Eve. So, it seems as if it was a lot of activities that occurred on Earth before Adam and Eve’s existence. The mystery is that were these sons of men including Wisdom were flesh or spiritual beings who inhabited the Earth? Were they powerful in flesh and blood? Was the Earth in its same location as it is today in the universe? If Wisdom was created before Earth was, it seems that she was apparently created in spirit form.

As mentioned earlier, the Earth is set in a lower world and the lower the atmosphere of a world the weaker the power of its inhabitable beings become. This is why again God dwells in the highest world in order for it to contain Him and the subsequent worlds following it. “...Dwelleth not in temples made with hands...”(Acts 17:24); this is referring to where God lives.

God not only created Wisdom, a powerful female spiritual being who governs her authority over us; but He also created other beings of higher power. Many of these beings were as gods or goddesses of certain things that influence our lives. Gods are considered as supernatural immortal beings of power and are referred to as the “lesser gods.” In the Book of Acts 14:8-12:“and there sat a certain man at Lystra, impotent in his feet, being a cripple from his mother’s womb, who never had walked. The same heard Paul speak (who was Saul miraculously converted and

leader of early Christianity)... who steadfastly beholding him and perceiving that he had faith to be healed. Said with a loud voice, stand upright on thy feet, he leaped and walked. When the people saw what Paul had done, they lifted up their voices saying in the speech of Lycaonia, the gods are come down to us in the LIKENESS OF MEN; and they called Barnabas(surname of Joseph who was accompanied by Paul as an apostle), Jupiter, Paul and Mercurius..." Jupiter is defined as a Roman god ruling over other lesser gods and all people. The god Jupiter was named after planet Jupiter by the Romans, because Jupiter represented as the largest planet with many storms; which the Jupiter god performed many times. Juno was a goddess of marriage, queen of the gods, wife of Jupiter and the second highest divinity; also represents as one of the small planets or asteroids which revolve around the sun between the orbits of Mars and Jupiter. In Acts 19:35..."the city of the Ephesians is a worshipper of the great goddess Dianna and of the image which fell down from Jupiter?"....and another god is Mars(god of war). What did it meant in the bible where it states that Paul was on Mars' hill? Paul couldn't have been on Mars if he, in continuance of Acts 17:22 ..."and said,"ye men of Athens, I perceive that in all things ye are too superstitious".

In Rome mythology, Jupiter had a temple built where worshippers would go. The Greeks believed that these gods lived in an ethereal atmosphere, which is an atmosphere of clouds, mist, glistening and very bright that is invisible for mortal eyes to view. As mentioned, the worlds of the heavens are too powerful for normal view in order to contain the powerful dwellers. These invisible homes consist of burnished gold, chased silver, and gleaming ivory(from elephants?); these were similar to the metals that were in the Garden of Eden. There were other palaces and homes below that housed even the lesser gods and demi-gods(half mortal; half immortal beings). All the planets of the Solar System were named after these gods and goddesses, because of the characteristics of each planet that each of the gods represented. Planets are defined as heavenly bodies with apparent motion as distinguish from the fixed stars including: the sun, moon, Mercury, Venus, Mars, Jupiter and Saturn. Now, any heavenly body that shines, by reflected light and revolves

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about the sun are the major planets in their order are: Mercury, Venus, Earth(as Gaea),Mars, Jupiter, Neptune, and Pluto. The minor planets are asteroids or planetoids that move in orbits between Mars and Jupiter.

The planets as gods are: Jupiter, Venus, Mercury, Mars, Saturn, Uranus(a personification of Heaven, regarded as a husband or son of Gaea named as Earth in English) who was overthrown by his son Saturn:

When Acts described gods coming down, they had to come down from the heavens; this phrase is usually used after a being comes from Heaven. Planets were not the only objects that represented beings and other creatures. There are certain stars that were created as guides for times and seasons. In Genesis, God said, “let there be lights that will be for signs, seasons, days, and years. The Star of Bethlehem was studied by the Magi as the 3 wise men who acknowledged the coming of the Messiah. We all were created in God’s image as well as His son’s. He was born under the guidance of His star. Jesus was spirit just like man was before coming to Earth, being first of all creations. Genesis reads, that God started His creation in the heavens, with the sun, moon, stars and planets and other celestial beings. In Colosians 1:13-16:“translated us into the kingdom of His dear Son: in whom we have redemption through His blood, even the forgiveness of sins. Who is the image of the invisible God and first of all creation of all born creatures: for by Him were all things created that are in Heaven and that are in the Earth; visible and invisible... and He is before all things.” This statement also includes that Jesus was created before His guided star. A star is defined as any heavenly body(celestial object) as a planet, meteor, the moon, etc. Referring back to how Jesus’ star was named as the Star of Bethlehem along with other star names. Since man was created in God’s image and likeness, along with Jesus as being the image of God; we are also born with stars that are named and numbered by God that has a special significance in each of us.

In Psalms 147:4, it states, “He telleth the number of the stars; He calleth them all by their names”. So are we connected to a star like Jesus was? What is the purpose of the stars for connection to the terrestrials, as what Jesus became? As mentioned earlier, we are about 98% of the

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mass of the universe. The element carbon is a great part of nature's matter. According to astronomers, we and the solar system are made of stardust along with other mass of the universe. This is what it meant when Jesus said that we are the "light of the world", and astronomers also researched in the text of the Unas Pyramid (4400 years ago) that we are indeed are connected to the stars; this ancient liturgy is one of Earth's oldest writings that was found. This was a complete religious text carved throughout 5 chambers of the Unas Pyramid. One of the carvings stated that the mother of Isis, "Nut" arches her celestial body as stars in the heavens. Star Sirius is Earth's brightest star and is about the size of it! There are other stars that are about the size of Earth that are called Carbon Stars, perhaps they are mostly made of carbon like rocks, animals, humans and plants are partially made of; things that are made of carbon or consist of it is considered organic, as we are, are considered as an organism. The stars that we see as our planets of the Solar System are considered as "failed stars" that are also called "brown dwarf stars" as being gaseous; mainly of hydrogen and helium; unable to shine compare to other stars that shines very bright:

There are many, many unexplained phenomenon about stars and its qualities and genetic makeup. However, this explain the reasons why stars that makes up the astrology signs that influence life on Earth and other stars that make up the powerful constellations have powers as well as other celestial beings. It's stated in the bible that every star has its own glory, meaning that all stars are not the same in quality and power. Before and after the birth of Jesus, His star was with Him. In Matthew 2:2: "...Where is He that is born king of the Jews? For we have seen His star in the east, and are come to worship Him." Also, Matthew 2:9-10: "when they had heard the king, they departed and lo, the star, which they saw in the east, went before them til it came and stood over where the young child was. When they saw the star they rejoiced with exceeding joy." The Star of Bethlehem is defined as a bright star hung over Bethlehem at the birth of Jesus of Nazareth, guiding the Magi to the manger; which were the 3 wise men from the east whom were priests having occult powers. So, when a spirit comes to Earth to become

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terrestrial that spirit remains connected to the celestial realm. Stars that are connected to terrestrials are connected to assigned spirits even before coming to a terrestrial atmosphere.

The spirit that's within the body is guided by a guiding light, for those who never quite understood what a guiding light was; this is what it is, a star that is connected to you. When God created the stars and said let them be for signs, He was not only referring to times; but also to when and how we were to be born on Earth. Without stars our spirits would not thrive in a body. In comparison to an antenna or a satellite that sends reception and signals to televisions; without these the television will be on, but no reception will come through and connection is lost. Likewise without the star that connects to the soul; while in the body or to the spirit once it leaves the body; the guidance and connection to your inner instinct will be lost, even though you may remain alive like a stationary plant. At the moment of conception, a spirit is entered into the zygote's matter and its star is immediately connected with that spirit. But what about in the case of Adam who was formed out of the ground instead of being created in the womb? How did his star connect to him? The possible answer to this is that when God breathed the breath of life into Adam, his star connected to his soul afterwards.

The breath of life was given by a celestial being who was God that created, counted and named all the stars. Terrestrials are connected through each powerful channel through some sort of celestial being. We are a great part of the universe in matter and in law called "karma", and for everything that is on Earth, seen and unseen; represented as a being or not represented as a being has a spiritual connection behind them. 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If you read Genesis 15:5, where it seems that God instructed Abraham to speak to the stars like: ““Abraham was childless and without heir, and God brought him forth to look upon the heavens and said, “TELL the stars if you are able to list them, and said so shall your seed be also.”” Other words, it seems that the same stars that we gazed at throughout our lives are not just hanging bright; but also are alive! So, keep wishing upon your star that you may receive messages or be blessed. Again this writing is not intended to change a belief or religion, it only gives certain facts of why we are here and how we got here. This writing collected facts from biblical statements as well as scientific ones.
