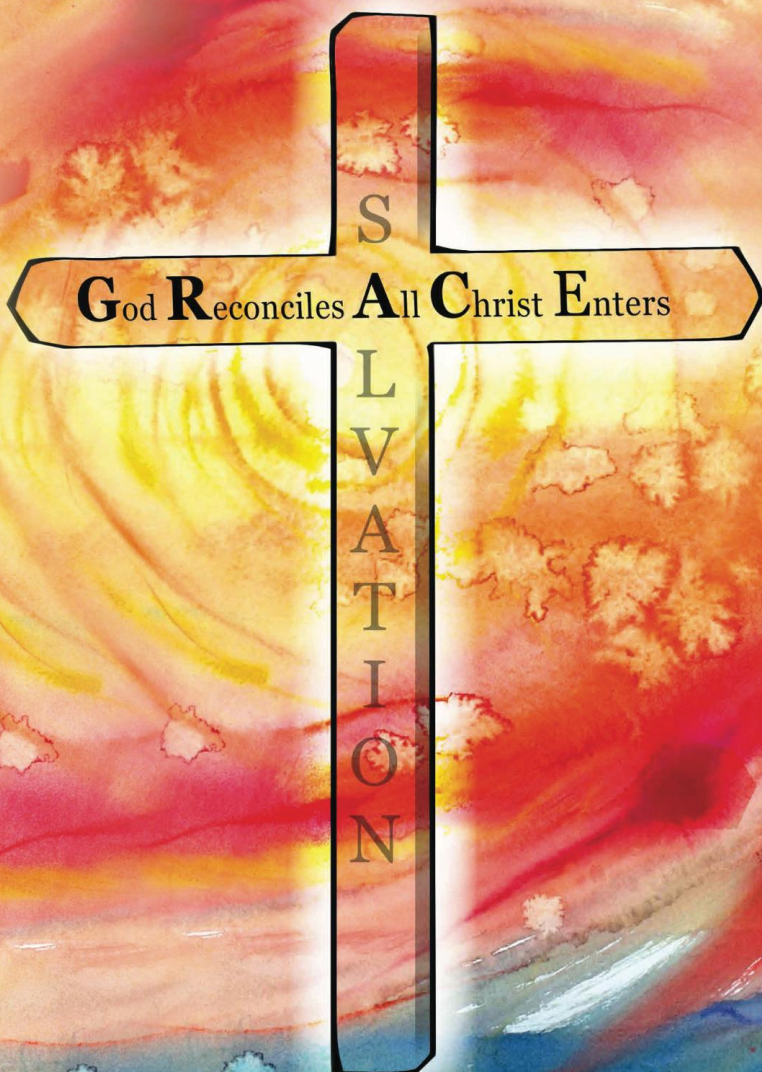

ABOUT THE BOOK COVER – SPECTRUM

**Place your hands in front of your face, as if you are

Each finger and thumb is spaced apart from each other and each has joints, lines and grooves. Notice how the left hand is symmetrically the same as the right hand. Hold your hands up to your face as in prayer. Open your hands.

Take in a deep breath through your nose and hold it for three seconds. Exhale through your mouth into your hands
