Ancient Chinese Civilization

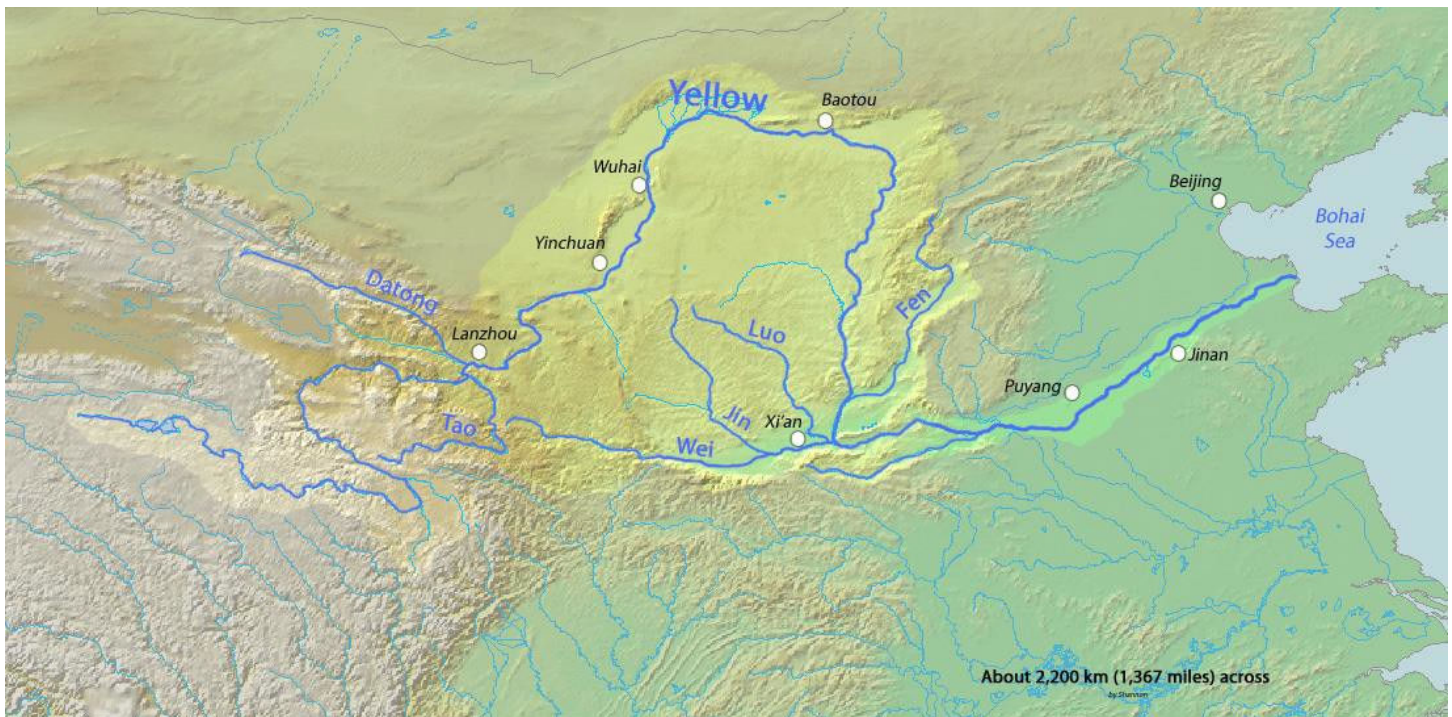
The **Huang River** (Yellow River) was essential to the growth of **ancient Chinese civilization**. This was because of the fertile soil created by its floodwaters.

- About 3,000 miles long
- Has many tributaries on the North China Plain
- Ends in the Yellow Sea
- Third-longest river in Asia



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
