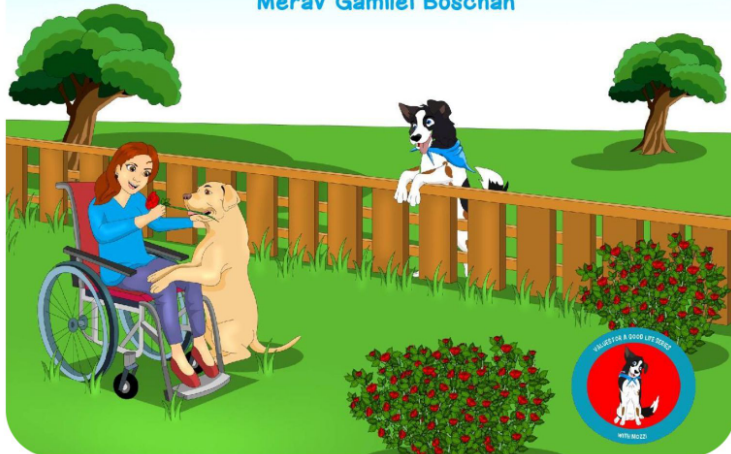

Then try Mozzi's favorite, a pat on the tummy,

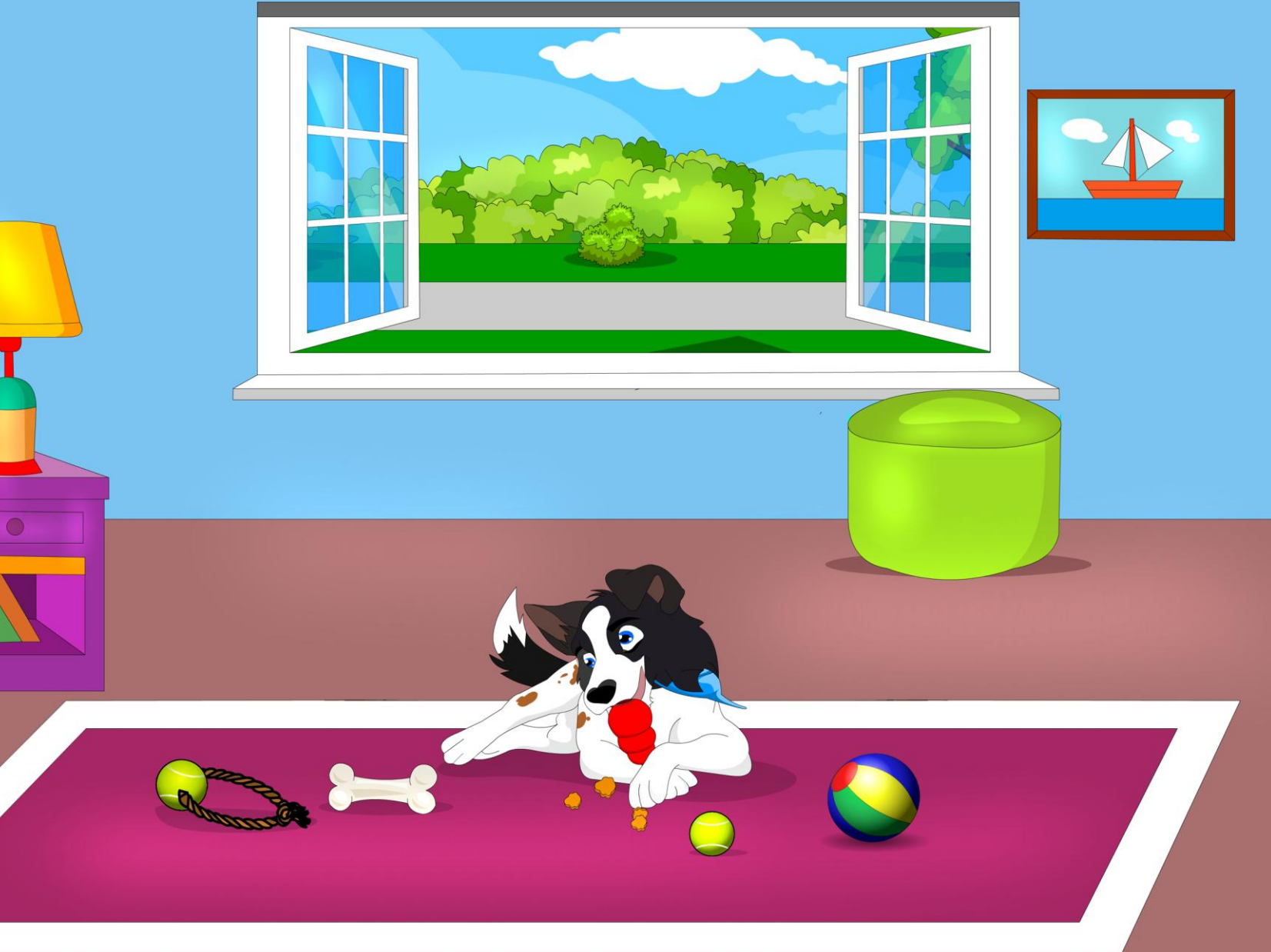


That means the dog isn't scared that you're near,

To get out the treats that are so good to chew!"

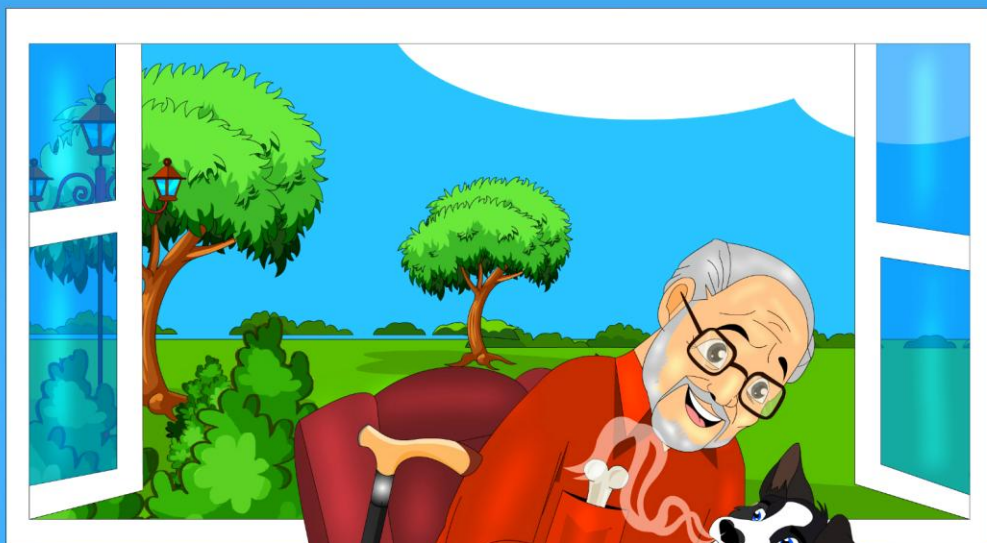


But - oh, no! One snack is stuck deep in Kong,

Yes! A treat in his pocket, where he'd hidden it well.

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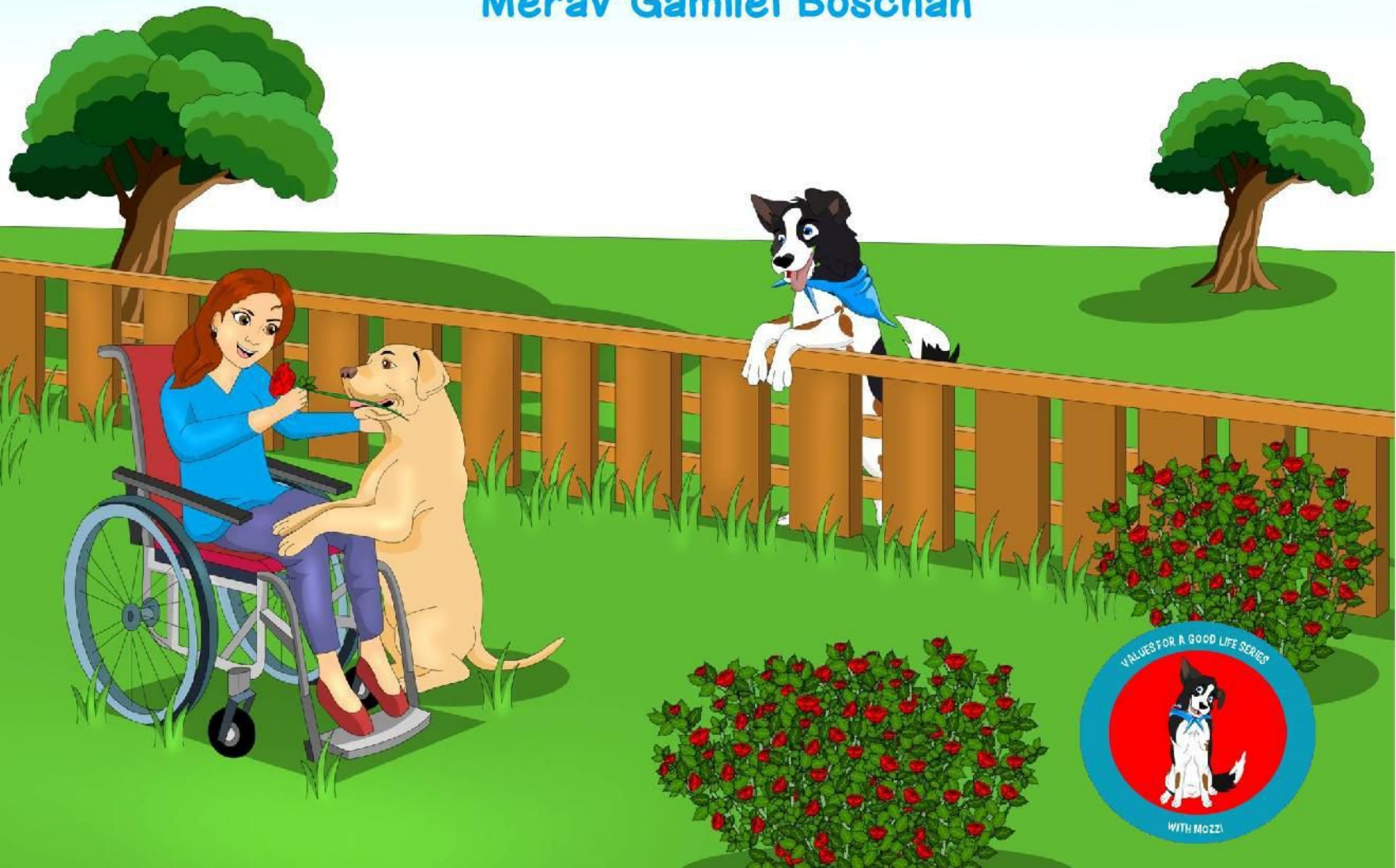
WITH FRIENDS LIKE THAT

Merav's life philosophy: Don't let your fears lead to a life filled with regrets. Embrace your dreams and enjoy the journey!

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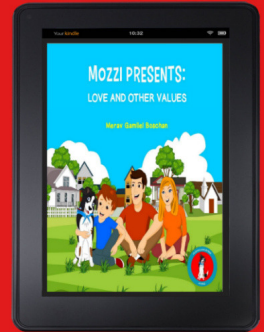
