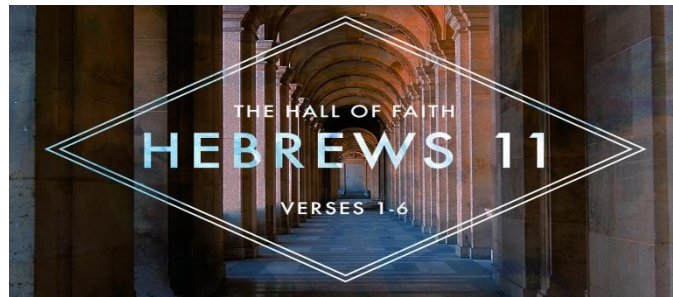


Day 1
