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INTRODUCTION

PIA sessions are designed to aid the Believers in releasing the power within. PIAS will provide you the opportunity to advance over the obstacles in the flesh through actual action exercises. PIAS will instill in you the confidence and boldness you need to face the enemy and minister healing and deliverance to others and yourself. It's design to heighten your expectation for miracles, signs, and wonders. PIAS are not sessions for operating in the Gifts of the Spirits (I Corinthians 12:4-11) PIAS can be used individually or as a group. In these sessions the Believer will be:

- Exercising: Faith
- Exercising: Authority over demons
- Exercising: Greater works activities

In **Mark 16:13-18** it is written, "He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the good news to all creation. Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned. And these signs will accompany those who believe: In my name they will drive out demons; they will speak in new tongues; they will pick up snakes with their hands; and when they drink deadly poison, it will not hurt them at all; they will place their hands on sick people, and they will get well."

Jesus said these signs will accompany those who believe: If you are not a Believer, but desire to become a Believer, please pray this prayer: Lord, I am a sinner. Please forgive me of my sins. Come into my heart and live your life through me. I receive you as my Saviour and Lord. Jesus fill me with the Holy Spirit, that I may have your power to live life as a Christian. Thank you, Lord. Amen.

Session & Action Exercises #2 Casting Down Imaginations

2 Corinth. 10:3-5 “For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh; (For the **weapons** of our warfare are not carnal, but **mighty through God** to the pulling down of strong holds;) **Casting down imaginations**, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;

Your imagination has divine power. It's a weapon against the enemy. But he works to turn your own weapon on you for evil.

imagination is formed from image

image – a reproduction or imitation of the form of a person or thing. A mental picture of something not actually present: IMPRESSION.

imagination – **1**: the act or power of forming a mental image of something not present to the senses never before wholly perceived in reality **2 : a** creative ability **3 a** : a creation of the mind; *esp* : an idealized or poetic creation **b** : fanciful or empty assumption

We are created in the image of God; therefore, Satan will work against the power of our imagination to keep us from being transformed into that image. He works to redirect the power of our imagination (creative ability) to produce negative things rather than good things. He put wrong thoughts in our mind, so we can imagine negative things about ourselves and what our present and future holds for us. In **Prov. 23: 7a** *it is written*, “For as he thinketh in his heart, so is he.”

He plays on our mind with fancy and futile assumptions. He desires to keep us seeing ourselves small and

Session & Action Exercises #5 The Suppressor of Light

^{V4} “The god of this age has blinded the minds of unbelievers, **so that they cannot see the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ**, who is the image of God. ⁶ For God, who said, “**Let light shine out of darkness**,” made his light to shine in our hearts to give us **the light of the knowledge of the glory of God** in the face of Christ.

suppress – to put down by authority or force: SUBDUE. to keep from public knowledge: as, **a**: to keep secret **b**: to stop or prohibit the publication or revelation of. to exclude from consciousness. to inhibit the growth or development of: STUNT.

suppressor – one that suppresses.

suppression – an act or instance of suppressing : the state of being suppressed.

distort – to twist out of the true meaning or proportion [*~ the facts*]. To twist out of a natural, normal, or original shape or condition. (PERVERT- to twist the meaning or sense of)

distortion – the quality or state of being distorted : a product of distortion: as **a**: a lack of proportionality in an image resulting from defects in the optical system **b**: falsified reproduction of an audio or video signal caused by change in the wave form of the original signal.
